- 3. The stairs in the new pavilion should be moved to the other side of the building, away from the door.
- 4. Power is in the new pavilion.
- 5. Joe Barletta submitted a quote for a handicap bathroom of \$5764. The board reviewed the quote & made a few changes. Mr. Barletta will submit a contract with the changes along with the amended price.
- 6. The town received a \$5000 grant from Legislator Ray Donley, to be used towards the handicap restroom in the town park.
