# SUPERVISOR REPORT:

- 1. Supervisor Osborn stated the Run For The Fallen was a success. The run started on June 9th in Watertown and ended in Albany on June 12, 2022. The runners made a stop at the Winfield Town Barn where there was a banner displayed in honor of the fallen.
- 2. Supervisor Osborn is working on the budget for 2023. Figured into the budget will be: \$37,000 to put toward the new fire truck, approximately a 13% increase for Excellus Blue Cross Blue Shield along with anticipating a raise for the Highway Department employees.

## **CLERK REPORT:**

1. Clerk Donley reported that 6 office chairs were assembled by Hummel's Office Plus and delivered.

## HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT REPORT:

- 1. Superintendent Jones stated tentatively Tuesday June 21st the Highway Department will stone and oil Truax Road.
- 2. Superintendent Jones will request quotes for a new pick-up truck as well as send a commitment letter out to Utica Mack for a new plow truck. Plow trucks are 2 years out per Utica Mack.

## PARK COMMISSIONER REPORT:

- 1. Commissioner Royce changed the reservations previously made for pavilion 1 to pavilion 2 or 3.
- 2. Mr. Royce observed stream erosion on the south bank of North Winfield Creek.
- 3. Highway Superintendent Jones stated he can probably demolish pavilion 1 in August if not sooner.
- 4. The board will find an engineer to draw up plans for constructing the bridge on the south side of the town park.

## **ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS:**

- 1. Mr. Watkins stated the Town of Litchfield is updating their Section 94-C, in regards to commercial solar and battery law.
- 2. The town may receive an estimate of \$8,000 through a NYS program called Pave Our Potholes.

### OLD BUSINESS:

1. A public hearing regarding the Commercial Solar and Battery Law will be held June 29th, 2022 at 6:00 pm. Anthony Gannon will put this advertisement in the WW Star.

The next Winfield Town Board Meeting will be held July 13, 2022 at 7 p.m.
